The most important decision we can make is to give our heart and life to Jesus Christ. A relationship with Jesus secures our eternal destiny and leads us to true fulfillment in life.

God shows His heart for us through His word. For example, in the book of Jeremiah we read:

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

(Jeremiah 29:11)

To discover and live these plans, we must seek to grow in the knowledge of God and in the application of His Word in our lives. Here we will summarize some of the most important truths of the word of God (the Bible), which will help you the first steps towards your spiritual growth.

As you follow God's plan for your life, we know you will experience incredible peace and joy from Him along the way. Let's get started!



All good construction starts with a good plan. This truth also applies to your life. A well-built life does not happen by chance, it requires a plan; and not just any plan, but the right plan. The right plan for your life starts with God. He has an incredible plan for you. It's an excellent plan that surpasses anything you could imagine or do and any plan others might have for you.

But there's a problem: by nature, we don't cooperate very well with our designer. In fact, we have an innate drive to live life our own way. We want to decide our own path. We like to be our own boss. And without realizing it, we either ignore, reject or do not pay attention to God.

Without a personal connection to God, our decisions in life are driven by our desires and feelings, or by the opinions and pressures of people around us. This prevents us from enjoying all the good that God has for us.

There is something else you should know: God's plan for your life actually goes beyond this life. God designed you to live forever: Yes! We are spirit, soul and body and the day will come when you will physically die, but there is a part inside you that will live forever in an eternal place. God wants you in that place to be with him!

God's plan is about having a personal relationship with him, now and for eternity. It is about you, voluntarily

allowing Him guide your life. It's about abandoning your tendency to ignore, reject or pay no attention to God. Instead, it is about accepting and following Him. It's about giving him complete control of your life.

The good news is that God has made this possible! He took the necessary measures to make sure that each person who is willing can

have a personal relationship with Him and can discover the plan He has for their life now and forever.

The path to a personal relationship with God is found in the Bible.

What steps do you need to take to have a personal relationship with God now and for eternity?

1 | Acknowledge God in your life.

We live apart from God. By nature, we ignore, reject or don't pay any attention to Him. We have a tendency to be our own boss and live apart from God instead of walking hand in hand with our creator. This is what the Bible calls sin.

We have all strayed from God. The Bible says so in **Romans 3:23 (NLT):** For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.

Acknowledging God in your life is the first step to getting closer to Him.

2 I Choose the right path.

When you choose the wrong path, the one with the "danger" sign, you end up in the wrong place. The same thing happens when we choose the path that leads us away from God rather than towards Him.

It's important to understand that sin—living apart from God—leads to death and destruction, instead of the life God desires for you.

Romans 6:23 (NLT)

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

3 | Know God's plan for your life.

The good news is that God is the solution! He opened a way through Jesus, with His death and His resurrection on the cross, so that you can leave the path of death and enter the path of life that He offers you. He did it because He loves you. He offers this solution as a gift to all who want to accept it.

Romans 5:8 (NIV)

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

John 3:16 (NIV)

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. Jesus is the way that God has provided through His death and resurrection. Jesus defeated sin and death on the cross for us. Now He invites us to believe in Him as our risen Lord and Savior. When we do, we change from the inside out and position ourselves on a new path—the path of life. This is the gift of salvation!

Romans 10:9, 10, 13 (DHH)

If you confess that Jesus is Lord and believe that God raised him from death, you will be saved. [...] For it is by our faith that we are put right with God; it is by our confession that we are saved. [...] As the scripture says, 'Everyone who calls out to the Lord for help will be saved.'

So, if you feel in your heart "I want to give God access in my life". The question is: Have you received Jesus as the Lord and Savior of your life? If you haven't, you can do it right now through a simple prayer and this is simply talking to God.

You can repeat this prayer or put it in your own words. Sincerely say these words to Jesus:

Our Father in heaven, today I want to give my life to Jesus. Lord Jesus, I believe in You and I know that You died for me. Forgive my sins, enter my heart now and make me Your child. Teach me Jesus to live for you the rest of my life, in Jesus' name.

4 I Move forward with God.

If you have said this prayer for the first time, congratulations!

The Bible says that this is like a seed that can grow. And you can continue to grow in your faith in Jesus by reading the Bible and getting together with friends who also put God first in their lives. Therefore, we invite you

to continue coming to church and to be part of this family.

The Bible also says that you are now a new person with a new life, a child of God. So, we encourage you to keep moving forward, growing step by step in your new life with God. ENCOURAGE YOU TO MOVE FORWARD, GROWING STEP BY STEP IN YOUR NEW LIFE WITH GOD.

John 1:12 (NIV)

Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

Colossians 2:6-7 (NLT)

And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness.



Watching something grow is fun and interesting. If you've ever planted a seed, it's super exciting to see the tiny sprouts germinate. It's thrilling to watch it grow and mature until it eventually produces fruit. Growing is wonderful and exciting!

If you have given your life to God by accepting Jesus Christ personally, you are like a seed that has been planted in the ground. God's life fills your spirit and soul. You receive spiritual potential. Everything you

need to grow and bear fruit is already within you. Are you ready?

Growth is not automatic Certain things must happen for the seed to grow in a healthy manner and eventually become а mature plant that bears much fruit. Someone must provide water. warmth. sunlight, and nutrients to the soil so the plant can reach its full potential.

HE GOOD NEWS IS THAT GOD HAS PROVIDED ALL THE RESOURCES NEEDED TO GROW.

The same happens in your spiritual life. You will experience God's plan for your life as you grow in your relationship with Him. The good news is that God has provided all the necessary resources to reach your full potential and live out the purposes He has designed you. These resources are available and will change your life for the better!

Now is the time to start watering, nourishing, and caring for the new life of Jesus within you. How can you do this?

We encourage you to follow these steps:

1 | Get a Bible and read it.

Jesus said that God's Word is the food that gives life. We need it to survive and grow in a healthy way.

Matthew 4:4 (DHH)

But Jesus answered, 'The Scripture says, "Human beings cannot live on bread alone, but need every word that God speaks." '

A great way to start storing God's Word in your heart is by reading the Bible every day for a few minutes. Take five or ten minutes daily to read a verse or a chapter and make it a habit. The Bible is a supernatural book that will transform your life. Store God's Word within you!

You might be thinking, "I don't know where to start or how to read the Bible."

Here are a few simple steps to help you:

- Get a version of the Bible that is easy to understand, such as the New International Version (NIV) or the New Living Translation (NLT). You can find them at a Christian bookstore, online, or simply download an electronic version on your phone or computer. A great site to download Bibles is: YouVersion.
- Before you start reading your Bible, ask God to help you understand it. He wrote it! The Holy Spirit will give you understanding - just ask Him!

STORING GOD'S WORD WITHIN YOU IS KEY TO YOUR SPIRITUAL GROWTH. Start with the book of John. Why? John tells the story of Jesus in a very clear way. As you read through the book, you will get to know Jesus Christ verse by verse. After finishing the book of John, continue with Matthew, Mark, and Luke. You can also read a Psalm or a Proverb every day.

- As you read the Bible, try to place yourself in the passage. Think about the emotions the people in the verses you're reading might have felt. This will make the Scriptures come alive and help you see how to better apply God's Word in your life.
- As you read the Bible, ask yourself these questions: How does this apply to me? What can I learn from this? How can this help me live for Jesus? If you wish, start a journal where you note your thoughts and the lessons learned from reading God's Word.
- Memorize God's Word. The Bible is organized by books, chapters, and verses. Start by memorizing some verses and promises from the Bible in your mind and heart. These will comfort, encourage, and help you day by day and throughout your life.

Psalm 119:11 (DHH)

I keep your law in my heart, so that I will not sin against you.

Storing God's Word inside your heart is key to your spiritual growth. Read it. Meditate on it. Memorize it. Feed on it every day.

2 | Pray and worship God.

To grow in your relationship with God, you need to connect with Him, and you can do this through prayer and worship. Prayer is talking to God about your life, bringing your needs and concerns to Him, knowing that He listens and answers. Worship is spending time with God; you can sing praises that come from deep within your heart, thank Him, and praise Him for how good He is.

Take time each day to talk to God and also to worship Him. He is your Heavenly Father and your friend.

Matthew 6:9-13 (NIV)

This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

Philippians 4:6-7 (NTV)

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

3 I Learn to think and live God's way.

Our way of thinking affects everything we do. If you think the wrong way, you will live the wrong way. Those who don't live for God have a set of values and priorities that are different from those who live for God.

To grow as a follower of Jesus, you must start thinking, valuing, and setting different priorities. You are now a new person with a new life, and this requires a new way of thinking!

The Bible describes this new way of thinking like this:

Philippians 4:8 (DHH)

In conclusion, my friends, fill your minds with those things that are good and that deserve praise: things that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely, and honorable.

Ephesians 4:21-24 (NLT)

Since you have heard about Jesus and have learned the truth that comes from him, throw off your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception.

Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.

Ephesians 4:23-24 (NLT)

Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.

This is how you will grow in your relationship with Jesus, and your life will start to bear good fruit.



To continue growing as a follower of Jesus, there are other important things you must do. Let's look at an example: muscles. Obviously, your muscles are an important part of your body. They provide strength, agility, and endurance. However, muscles will never reach their full potential without effort, activity, and exercise.

Similarly, you must do everything you can to develop strong spiritual muscles. Why? Because they will help you stay firm in your relationship with Jesus, overcome the temptations you face, and help others come to know Jesus as you have come to know Him.

To develop strong spiritual muscles, here are some steps you can follow:

1 | Be part of a church that believes in and teaches the Bible.

The Christian life was not designed to be lived alone. When you invited Jesus into your life, God brought you into His family; we are a family going to heaven together.

To grow as a follower of Jesus, you must be part of the church. It is there where we gather to praise, learn, and serve together. It is where we connect and work together to reach those who need to know and experience God's love. The Bible clearly teaches us this:

Psalm 92:13 (NLT)

For they are transplanted to the Lord's own house. They flourish in the courts of our God.

Hebrews 10:25 (NLT)

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

No church is perfect. In prayer, ask God to guide you in choosing a Christ-centered church—one that believes in and teaches the Bible, feels like family, and supports your growth in the Christian faith. If you believe this is your church, we would be happy for you to be a part of the Caminodevida family.

2 | Take the Growth Track and participate in a small group.

You can take this track on Sundays after each service. There are only 3 sessions and they will help you take the next step in your relationship with God and learn more about the church.

God uses people to help you grow, and the best way to get to know us and make friends is by participating in small groups and service teams that collaborate with the church. God heals and matures us through these interpersonal relationships.

In the free small groups, common interests are shared, and prayer takes place. Participants encourage one another, work in unity, and frequently help each other out. This is how they grow together.

There are also curriculum-based small groups where, through teachings and conversations, foundations of God's Word are established in practical areas such as finances, parenting, marriage, women, men, and more.

Take advantage of all the available resources, as they will help you advance in your spiritual development.

3 | Make your faith public and get baptized.

Our relationship with God is personal, but it is not private. It is necessary for you to publicly identify as a follower of Jesus. Listen to what He Himself said:

Matthew 10:32-33 (NLT)

Everyone who acknowledges me publicly here on earth, I will also acknowledge before my Father in heaven. But everyone who denies me here on earth, I will also deny before my Father in heaven. We publicly demonstrate our commitment to Jesus in several ways.

This can happen when the pastor extends an invitation to receive Jesus during a service at the church. If you decide to take this step, everyone in the church will celebrate your decision. IT IS NECESSARY FOR YOU TO PUBLICLY IDENTIFY YOURSELF AS A FOLLOWER OF JESUS.

Also, it takes place when we communicate our commitment to Jesus to our family and friends. In your daily interactions, share with others that you are a follower of Jesus. Don't be ashamed or fearful!

When you share your faith with others, you will receive different responses: Some will react positively, others may be happy for you but not interested in it for themselves, and there will be some who won't understand or support this new life you now have even becoming hostile about it.

No matter how others respond, always be kind, patient, and keep praying. Don't let anyone's response, whether positive or negative, affect your faith.

Water baptism is another way to publicly declare our faith in Jesus. The Bible teaches us that baptism is an important step of obedience for those who believe in Jesus.

Jesus Himself gave us the example by being baptized:

Matthew 3:13-17 (NLT)

Then Jesus went from Galilee to the Jordan River

to be baptized by John. But John tried to talk him out of it. 'I am the one who needs to be baptized by you,' he said, 'so why are you coming to me?' But Jesus said, 'It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires.' So, John agreed to baptize him. After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on him. And a voice from heaven said, 'This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy.'

As soon as Jesus was baptized, He came up out of the water. At that moment, heaven was opened, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is My Son, whom I love; with Him, I am well pleased."

Jesus commanded His followers to be baptized to demonstrate to the world that they were truly His followers:

IT IS NECESSARY FOR YOU TO PUBLICLY IDENTIFY YOURSELF AS A FOLLOWER OF JESUS.

LIVE TO HONOR GOD

Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT)

Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

In baptism, the person is fully immersed in water, symbolizing to everyone present a total surrender to Jesus; in other words, it means dying to your old way of living and rising up with a new life in Jesus Christ.

Start living according to the Word of God.

By accepting Jesus into your life, you are a new person in Him. He has made a change in you from the inside out, and as you seek God more and get to know His heart, you will begin to see life in a different way. Your decisions, values, and principles will change as a result of your relationship with Jesus. All of this is part of your spiritual growth.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

Live to honor God. Regularly ask yourself, "What would Jesus do?" and "What does the Bible say about this?". This way, you will make better decisions that lead to a better life.

Put God first in the use of your time, your resources, and your talents.

The use of your time, resources, and talents is important to God. He desires that you make the most of everything He has given you.

Remember that everything you have ultimately comes from God and belongs to Him. As a follower of Jesus, you must now put God first and manage everything He has given you by His way of doing it. Ask Him to show you how to obey in these areas. By doing so, you will be blessed!

Believe in God's promises for your life.

Throughout the Bible, God makes incredible promises to all who love Him.

Here are some promises from God that will encourage you in your walk with Jesus:

• You have been forgiven.

Ephesians 1:7 (NLT)

He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins.

1 John 1:9 (NLT)

But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

• You have been justified with God and have peace with Him.

Romans 5:1 (NLT)

Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us.

• You have a new life in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

• The Holy Spirit lives in you.

Romans 8:11 (DHH)

If the Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from death, lives in you, then he who raised Christ from death will also give life to your mortal bodies by the presence of his Spirit in you.

• You have eternal life.

1 John 5:13 (NIV)

I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.

These promises help you when you believe and trust in them. God is trustworthy. When He promises something, He fulfills it! For example, if you don't feel forgiven for something bad you've done, cling to this promise:

1 John 1:9 (NLT)

But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

Allow God's promises to be stronger than your emotions. If you do, your emotions will change over time.

The decision to give your life to Jesus Christ is the greatest and best decision you could ever make. Surrender everything. Start growing. Don't give up in difficult times. Your best days are yet to come!

Philippians 1:6 (DHH)

And so I am sure that God, who began this good work in you, will carry it on until it is finished on the Day of Christ Jesus.

Always remember that God loves you. He is on your side and will always help you. Learn to know Him and trust in Him. Obey Him always, and you will experience blessings beyond what you can imagine.
